

DBRCA Club Meeting  
23<sup>rd</sup> of April 2011

9:30am The President opened the meeting and asked to proceed without a quorum. There were 19 members in attendance. Motion was made, seconded and carried to proceed.

**Reading of the minutes:** Minutes from the last meeting were read by Chris Davenport

**Treasurers Report:** It was reported that the current bank balance was \$6181.42

**Old Business:**

**Insurance**

Ron and another club member contacted the AMA regarding insurance coverage while participating in events away from the club flying site such as the New Smyrna Balloon and SkyFest. Each AMA member is individually covered to 2.5 Million. Property belonging to the site of the event is not covered. It was mentioned that site insurance would be a good idea for next year.

**New Smyrna Balloon and SkyFest**

Airboss at airshow would like us back next year. We will be provided a booth where we can provide information to people how to get started in rc aircraft.

**Runway fabric**

Doug found a person who would be able to prepare the runway for fabric at a reduced cost. The cost would be \$1750.00 and includes: leveling an area of 300ft X 30ft, 3 pieces of heavy machinery, laser grating, backfill and rolling. An additional cost of \$150 per load will be charged to remove remaining material from site.

There needs to be 6" of fabric on each side to roll the fabric over. This means the runway width will be 29ft.

**Total Cost:**

Fabric 150ft X 30ft \$750 X 2 =	\$1500.00
Shipping: \$130.00 X2 =	\$260.00
Preparation of surface:	\$1750.00
Material Removal per load:	\$150.00
	~\$3660.00

Once project is complete, most likely closer to \$4000. Motion was made and the project voted upon. Passed.

Terry motioned to take \$1500.00 dollars out of the bank and set aside for the runway. Motion was voted upon and passed.

**New Business:**

Terry is going to do some work on the mower deck to lower the blades even more.

Doug offered to cut grass for Bud on Wednesday's at 9am. Everyone, please help Doug and be here at 9am to assist.
